

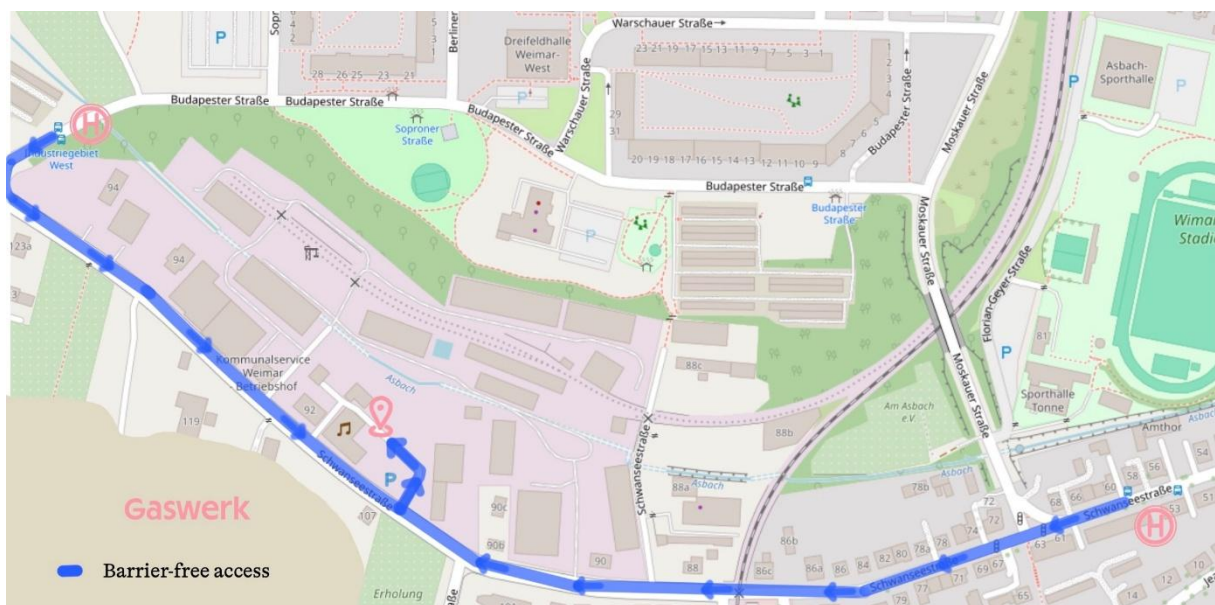
Gaswerk

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1. Map

2. Directions and Arrival

You can reach us by **bus**. Line 7, get off at the “Weimar, Schwanseestraße” stop. From there, it’s a 650-metre walk. Line 3 or 225, get off at the “Weimar, Industriegebiet West” stop. From there, it’s a 400-metre walk.

From the “Weimar, Schwanseestraße” bus stop, **walk** straight on along Schwanseestraße. Pass the Backwerkstatt, past U9 Fitness Pur and the railway tracks until you reach the gate of the Gaswerk. It will be open during the exhibition’s opening hours and at events. There will be signs indicating that the art festival is taking place (Figure 2). From the “Weimar, Industriegebiet West” bus stop, walk down the slight incline to the junction. Then turn left onto Schwanseestraße. Follow

the road past the first gate marked 'gaswerk'. The second gate (Figure 2) is the entrance. It will be open during the exhibition's opening hours and at events. There will be signs indicating that the art festival is taking place.

You can reach us by **car**. There is a small car park for visitors at the Gaswerk. There is a small kerb (Figure 3).

3. Accessibility of Ground and Building

The path from the "Weimar, Schwanseestraße" stop is level and paved, and is partly divided into pedestrian and cycle paths.

The path from the "Weimar, Industriegebiet West" stop is paved and partly divided into pedestrian and cycle paths. There is a slight incline.

The floor inside the building is mostly at ground level. There are small rises, but these are accessible by wheelchair (Figure 4).

4. Bathroom Situation

There is a wheelchair-accessible toilet. It is located inside the building. It is in between the non-wheelchair-accessible toilets. The wheelchair-accessible toilet has doors on both sides, which can be locked from the inside.

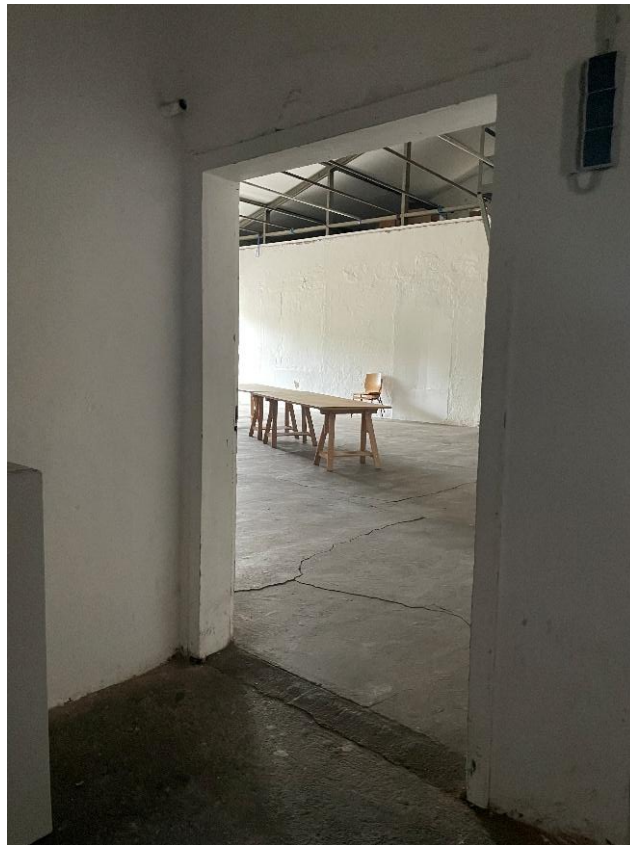


Figure 5: The first venue is on a lawn. You can see it as you walk further in from the car park. There is a small kerb running around the edge of the lawn.
