

“Festwiese” Apolda

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1. Directions and Arrival

We recommend that you book the free **shuttle service** between Weimar and Apolda when booking your tickets.

You can reach us by **car**. We are accessible by car. There are paid parking spaces near the “Festwiese”. There are also disabled parking spaces in the “Wiesenstraße” car park (Gate 1).

It is difficult to reach us by **bus**. From Apolda railway station, bus 280 runs hourly towards “Jena, Busbahnhof”. Get off at the “Apolda, Jenaer Straße” stop. From there, it is about a 15-minute walk to the “Festwiese”. Please note that the route may not be suited for walking by foot. For the return journey, you can also take bus 280.

2. Accessibility of the Venue

The „Festwiese“ has little vegetation (Figure 1). The ground consists of small stones. You can sit on the slope of the meadow. If you want to avoid inclines, you can also sit in the area in front of the slope (Figure 3). There will be chairs available.

3. Bathroom Situation

During the performance, there will be wheelchair-accessible and non-wheelchair-accessible bathrooms on the “Festwiese”, which are accessible without slopes.
