

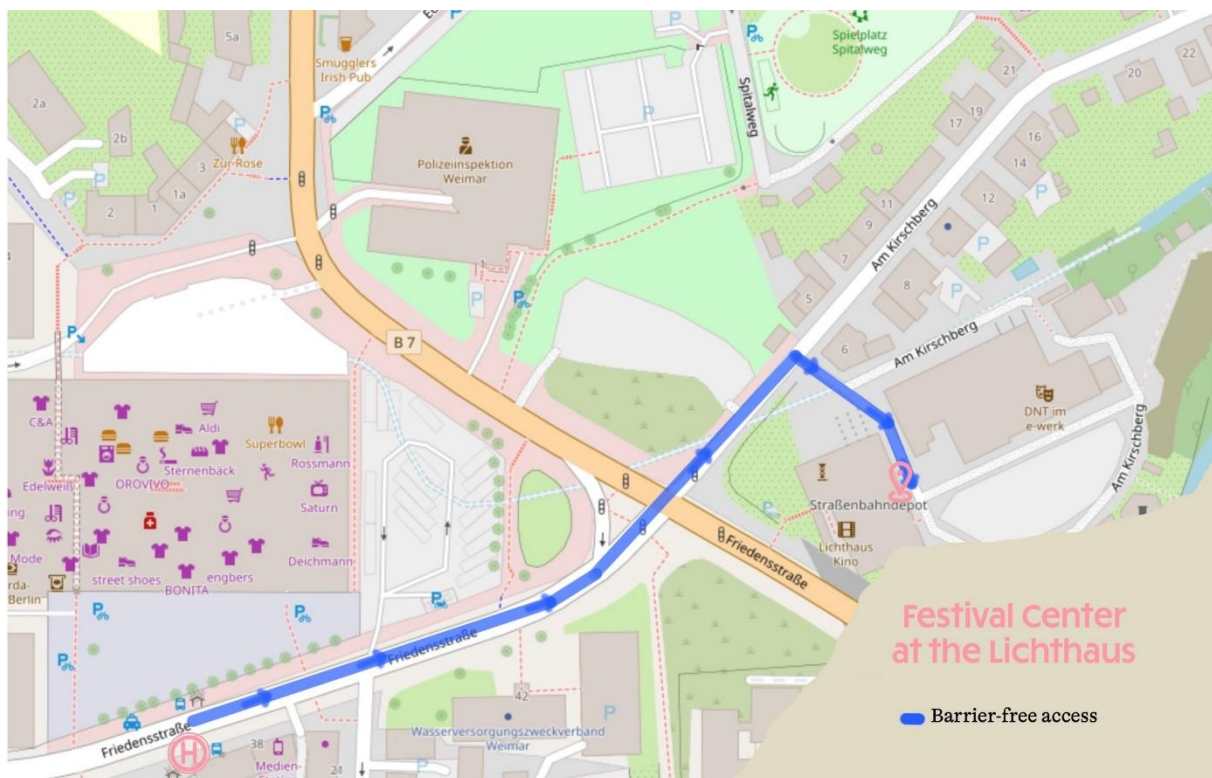
Lichthaus

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1. Map

2. Directions and Arrival

You can reach us by **bus**. Lines 1, 2, and 3, get off at the „Weimar, Friedensstraße/Atrium“ stop. From there, it’s a 180-metre walk.

Walk down Friedensstraße for 3 minutes and cross at the traffic lights. Walk along the street Am Kirchberg and turn right into the courtyard of the E-Werk (Figures 2, 3 and 4). The building on your right will have its gates open, marking the entrance to the festival centre.

You can reach us by **car**. The underground car park in the Atrium is 260 metres away and has disabled parking spaces. Parking is available 24/7. After the first 60 minutes, parking costs €0.50 for every half-hour or part thereof.

3. Accessibility of Ground and Building

The ground outside the E-Werk is paved, uneven and has an incline.

A ramp leads into the festival centre (Figure 5).

The festival centre is at ground level; it is somewhat narrow in places, but easy to navigate (Figures 6 and 7).

4. Bathroom Situation

The toilets are located at the Lichthaus cinema in a purple container.

During the art festival, accessible toilets are available at the E-Werk.
