

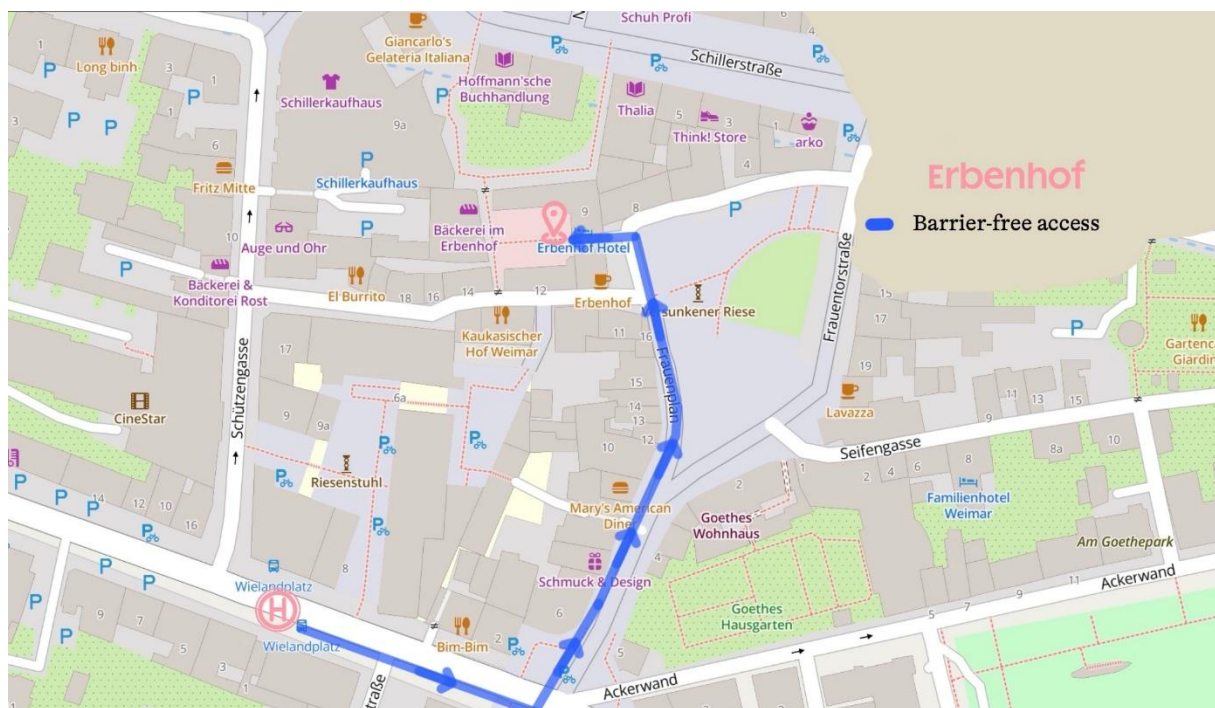
Erbenhof

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1. Map

2. Directions and Arrival

You can reach us by **bus**. Lines 1, 4, 5, 6 and 8, get off at the “Weimar, Wielandplatz” stop. From there, it’s a 210-metre walk.

Walk past the Stadtbücherei Weimar (Weimar City Library) along Steubenstraße. Turn left onto Frauenplan after you’ve passed the Nahkauf Heyer. Walk straight on, past the Goethe Fountain on the left, until you reach the end of the street. There is an archway on your left. This is the entrance to the Erbenhof.

You can reach us by **car**. There are paid parking spaces available 24/7, as well as disabled parking spaces. The “Schillerkaufhaus” underground car park is 150 metres away. It costs €2 per hour. Card payments are accepted. The underground car park at the “Goethehaus” is 270 metres away. It costs €2 per hour. Only cash payments are accepted.

3. Accessibility of Ground and Building

The path to the Erbenhof is unevenly paved. There are no stairs.

In the courtyard and concert area of the Erbenhof, the ground is level and asphalted.

4. Bathroom Situation

There are accessible toilets.

5. Figures
